Content and Communication [3 marks]

- Award 3 marks if a candidate has covered five points with some elaboration.

- Award 1 mark if there is limited coverage of the required points.
- Award **0** if there is no relevant information communicated.

Accuracy and Quality of Language [3 marks]

- Very accurate: application of grammar structures and vocabulary. [3 marks]
- Good level of accuracy: a generally sound application of grammar structures and vocabulary. [2 marks]
- Fairly accurate: satisfactory application of grammar structures and vocabulary. [1 mark]
- Difficulty in communicating the relevant information, very limited knowledge of the language. [0]

General appreciation [1 mark]

Legible handwriting, coherent structure, punctuation [1 mark]

Question 3 [Total: 10 marks]

Content and Communication [5 marks]

- Award **5 marks** if a candidate has covered five points with some elaboration
- Award 4 marks if a candidate has covered five points but not all with detail
- Award 2-3 marks if there is limited coverage of the required points
- Award 0-1 if there is very little relevant information communicated

Accuracy and Quality of Language [5 marks]

- Very accurate: a sound application of grammar, vocabulary and structures [5 marks]
- Good level of accuracy: a generally sound application of grammar, vocabulary and structures [4 marks]
- Fairly accurate: satisfactory application of grammar, vocabulary and structures [2-3 marks]
- Difficulty in communicating the relevant information, very limited knowledge of the language [1 mark]
- Substantially inaccurate: no knowledge of the language [0]
