- how it will benefit the society

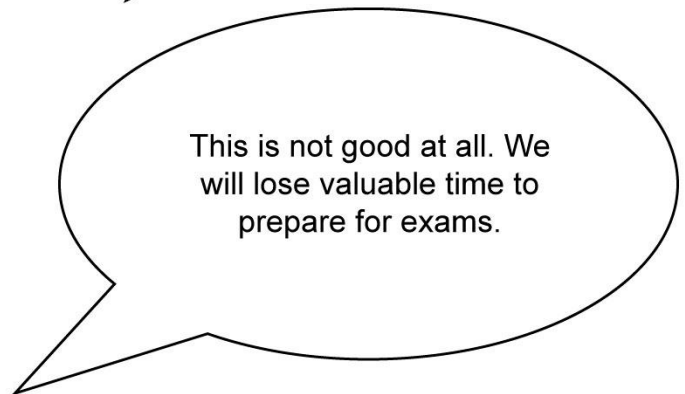
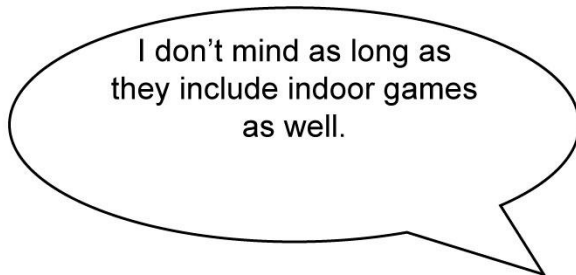
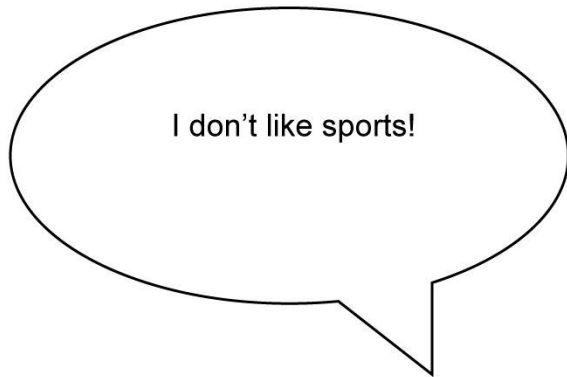
**Your speech should be about 150 - 200 words long.**
