### Instructions:

There are three (3) projects listed below. Choose one (1) project.
 Follow the design process to do the write up and in making each of the products.

## (a) Compose and Perform: Drama and Music.

- (i) Prepare a script (with at least two scenes) that will be used to educate learners in your school on "Child Trafficking".
- (ii) Design and make a puppet and costume for the main character.
- (iii) Collect musical instruments for accompaniment.
- (iv) Prepare a poster to advertise the performance.

## (b) Make a model of a windmill

- (i) Use an A3 hard paper as a working base e.g. cardboard.
- (ii) Use materials from the environment to make the structure.
- (iii) Show creativity and good finishing.
- (iv) Cost and prize this product.
- (v) Make a poster to advertise the product.

- (ii) Use old newspapers or cardboard boxes for the pulp to be used when making this product.
